



OPEN POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Benton Washington Regional Public Water Authority is currently accepting resumes for the position of **Maintenance Assistant or Maintenance Specialist 1/2**. This involves technical work in maintaining a water treatment plant and water transmission system. This is a Monday through Friday 7:00 AM through 3:30 PM shift with occasional weekend and /or holiday work required. Minimum requirements are to be at least age 18, have a HS Diploma or GED, be able to swim, and **have a valid Driver's License with a clean driving record**. Applicants with current Arkansas Dept of Health Water Distribution License (Grade 4 required for advancement) and experience in working in Water Distribution will be given preference; however, paid training for licensing can be provided for the right applicant.

Basic Job Skill Requirements:

1. This position requires that an individual have some experience in maintenance activities and have a general working knowledge of pumps and motors and hydraulic / pneumatic systems, as well as; a general working knowledge of the tools and associated equipment utilized in maintenance activities.
2. The employee must be able to pick up a minimum of 75 pounds at waist height and handle that load without injury or loss of control.
3. They must be able to climb up and down stairs, ramps, ladders, and properly enter confined spaces associated with the Authority's worksites. They must be able to climb up to a height of 250 feet on elevated storage tanks utilizing proper safety equipment. They must also be able to work outdoors safely in all weather conditions that can occur in Northwest Arkansas.
4. Must be able to safely operate motorized equipment Including but not limited to lawn mowers, tractors, pumps, generators, lawn trimmers.

Starting pay is dependent on qualifications and licensing and ranges from \$15.00 - \$25.00 per hour (potentially more with license and experience) and most benefits begin 30 days after hire. Benefits include health, dental, vision, and life insurances, vacation and sick leave, paid holidays, and 6% matching 457 retirement plan after 1 year employment. Applicants must be willing to submit to and pass both pre-employment background / criminal history check and pre-employment drug testing done at the time of interview. **All positions at BWRPWA are deemed safety sensitive under Arkansas Act 593.**
