That has now been slowed to 12 hours per day Table Rock is currently at 917.42’ which is in the Flood Pool (917’ top of seasonal power pool), and Bull Shoals is at 659.93’ which is in their Flood Pool (Top of seasonal power pool 659’) Both Table Rock and Bull Shoals are doing continuous power production
