Currently they are generating 16-20 hours daily at 3,800 cfs. Table Rock is currently at 909.23” which is in the Power Pool (915’ top of seasonal power pool), and Bull Shoals is at 652.49’ which is in their Power Pool (Top of seasonal power pool 659’) Table Rock is doing intermittent power production and Bull Shoals is doing continual power production similar to Beaver Lake schedule..
