Currently the Corp is maintaining lake at top of Power Pool level. Table Rock is currently at 917.70" which is in the Flood Pool (917' top of seasonal power pool), and Bull Shoals is at 659.30' which is in their Power Pool (Top of seasonal power pool 662') Table Rock is doing continuous power production and Bull Shoals is doing continual power production similar to ranging from low to high turbine release daily.
