Currently they are generating 8 -9 hours daily 3,800 cfs. while maintaining current lake level. Table Rock is currently at 911.48” which is in the Power Pool (915' top of seasonal power pool), and Bull Shoals is at 655.90' which is in their Power Pool (Top of seasonal power pool 659') Table Rock is doing continuous power production and Bull Shoals is doing intermittent power production similar to Beaver Lake schedule..
