Currently the Corp is Generating at 3800 cfs and opened one spillway gate on 7/07/26 at 2,000 cfs. Table Rock is currently at 916.93" which is at top of its Power Pool (917' top of seasonal power pool), and Bull Shoals is at 662.34' which is in their Flood Pool (Top of seasonal power pool 661') Table Rock is doing intermittent power production at 12,000 cfs and Bull Shoals is doing continual power production ranging from 12,000 cfs release to over 20,000 cfs turbine release daily. 1 cfs = 449 gallons per minute
